AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE (LDC) ZONING DISTRICT MAP; PROVIDING FOR REZONING OF APPROXIMATELY 0.31 ACRES OF PROPERTY, GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF PINE HILL ROAD APPROXIMATELY 295 FEET EAST OF OAKLEAF AVENUE, AND LEGALLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING DISTRICT DESIGNATION FOR SAID PROPERTY FROM THE GENERAL COMMERCIAL (C-2) ZONING DISTRICT TO THE LIGHT INDUSTRIAL (LI) ZONING DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
