New driveways and/or driveway extensions require a permit and must comply with regulations regarding location, surface materials, setback, dimension and impervious surface ratio and drainage:			
Submit a recent survey or site plan drawn to scale (show scale) with property boundaries, dwelling, existing driveway, proposed driveway, fences, landscaping and any other structure within the vicinity of the proposed driveway. Provide dimensions of the existing and proposed driveway that may be verified with the scale;			
Show the direction of proposed drainage from new driveway surface that flows toward drainage easements or street (not towards and onto adjacent properties). Use arrows to indicate flow direction ———;			
Show the location of the driveway so that	it complies with Section 11.05.00		
Provide a minimum three-foot setback from side and rear property lines;			
Add note regarding material thickness : that all portions of a driveway in the right-of-way (public property) will be six inches thick concrete			
Calculate the maximum impervious lot coverage for the property. This coverage is calculated by adding all building areas at one level (footprint) plus all drives, walks, patios, sheds, swimming pools and deck, etc. The maximum shall not exceed 60 percent of the overall lot.

Plans and permit must be posted and available for inspector at the job site.
